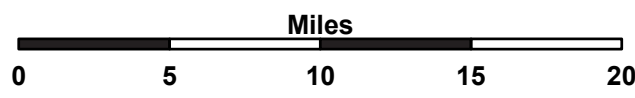
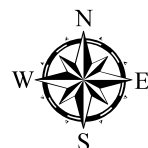
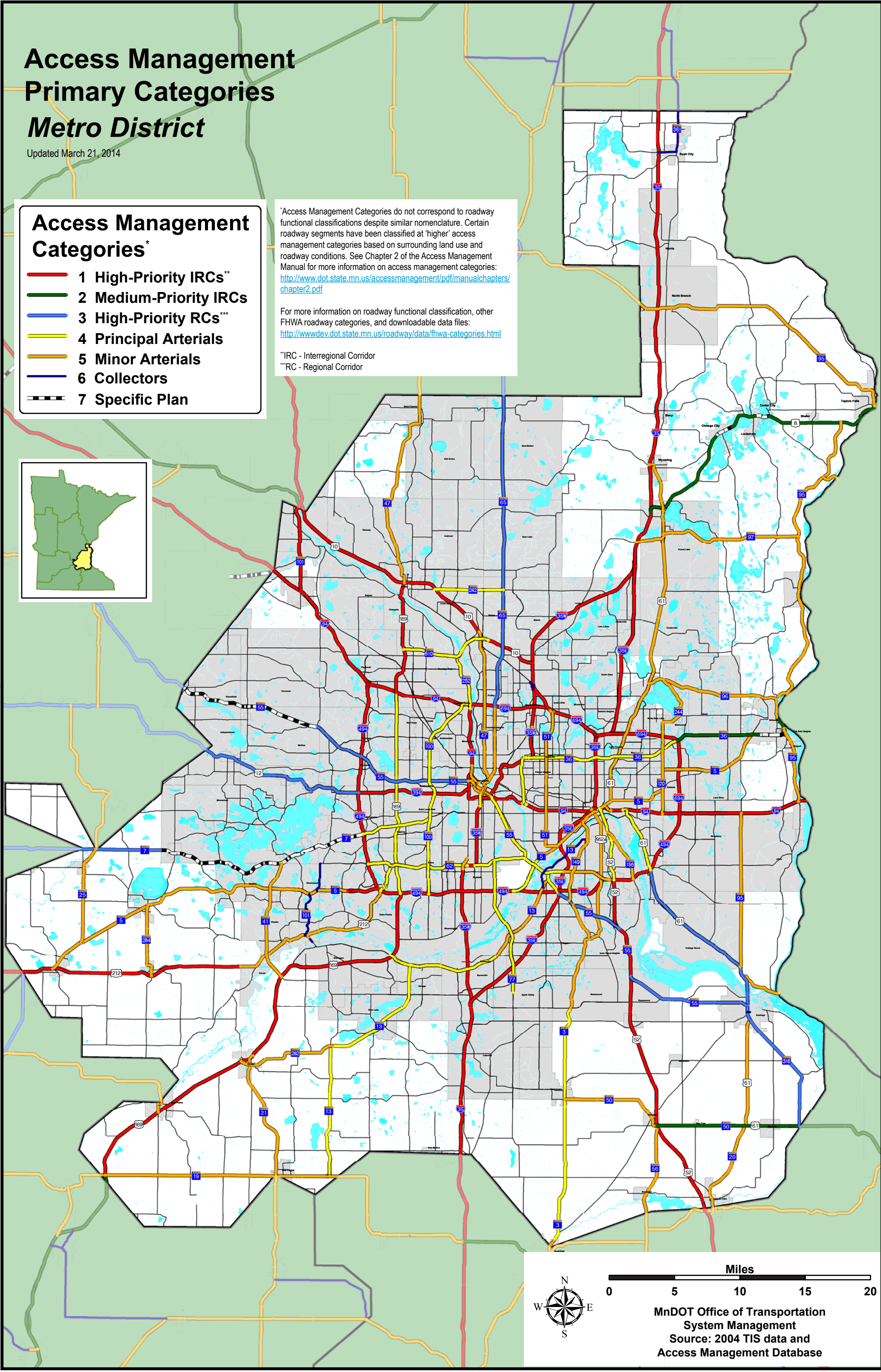
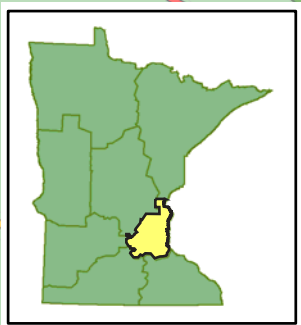
Access Management Categories*

*Access Management Categories do not correspond to roadway functional classifications despite similar nomenclature. Certain roadway segments have been classified at 'higher' access management categories based on surrounding land use and roadway conditions.
